## BEFORE YOU APPLY

Learn about our application requirements and important dates and deadlines before you start the application process.

### PREREQUISITES

You must complete the prerequisite courses by May of the year you matriculate. For full list of required courses please visit: [med.fau.edu/admissions/md/reqpro.php](http://med.fau.edu/admissions/md/reqpro.php)

### MCAT

You must take the Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) no later than Fall preceding the year in which you aspire to enroll. Scores cannot be more than 3 years old at the time of application.

### CASPer™

All applicants must complete an online computer-based situational judgement test. Visit: [takeCASPer.com](http://takeCASPer.com)

### OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the United States.

Applicants must have a Bachelor's degree from a North American based institution with regional accreditation.

## HOW TO APPLY

Once you've decided to apply to become a MedOwl, you must complete the online American Medical College Application Service (AMCAS) application, CASPer® test and FAU Schmidt College of Medicine Supplemental application. It is the responsibility of each applicant to meet established deadlines and to monitor the status of their applications.



### MAY - NOVEMBER 15

Applicants may begin completing their AMCAS application in May. The application deadline is November 15th. [students-residents.aamc.org](http://students-residents.aamc.org)



### JUNE - JANUARY 15

Applicants should complete the CASPer® test.



### JULY 15- DECEMBER 31

FAU Schmidt College of Medicine sends invitations to applicants to complete a secondary application if appropriate criteria are met. A \$30 non-refundable application fee is required. FAU Schmidt College of Medicine does not have its own Fee Assistance Program (FAP), however we will accept the FAP issued by the AAMC.



### JULY - MARCH

Completed applications are reviewed. Competitive applicants begin to receive interview invitations starting in August. Interviews are conducted at the FAU College of Medicine from September through February. Acceptances are on a rolling basis and are released after October 15.



### APRIL

Accepted applicants will be invited to attend the Second Look event at the Schmidt College of Medicine. This event provides accepted students an opportunity to revisit the FAU campus and further explore the experience of FAU medical student.
